The City of Albuquerque is conducting an engineering study of Fourth Street from Mountain Road to Solar Road. This study is the next step in the North Fourth Street Rank III Corridor Plan planning process. The purpose of the study is to evaluate roadway improvement concepts contained in the Corridor Plan and to identify a preferred roadway concept based on Corridor Plan guidance to carry forward in future project planning.

The City has identified alternative concepts for street sections and streetscape options and will host several public involvement workshops to present these concepts and to obtain input and feedback from stakeholders and the community. **The first workshop will focus on issues specific to the Mountain Road to I-40 segment of Fourth Street to target stakeholders and to gather input specific to this segment.**
